The Cathedral has opened for a gathered Mass. We are still limited to a 10person capacity which includes the celebrant & assisting ministers.

- Mass will be offered at 4 pm Saturday, 8:30 & 11:30 am Sunday and weekdays (Monday-Friday) at 12N with minimal seating. We ask that you call the week of the Mass you are planning on attending.
- Please remain home if you are feeling ill or susceptible to the virus. Mass will continue to be livestreamed at 11:30 am every Sunday.
- We ask that you arrive 15 minutes prior to the Mass time you've signed up for to check in.
- Masks are required at all times. Please bring your own mask.
- Please be considerate of others & only plan to attend 1 mass per week. (keep in mind it might be 2-3 weeks out before attending another Mass)

We will continue with private prayer M-F The times are: Monday–Friday- 8-9 am; & 5-6pm; Saturday –2:30-3:30pm this is only for private prayer and confessions.
