The Feast of Pentecost is actually the birthday of the Church. Celebrate this feast with a birthday cake for the Church. Place seven candles on the cake to represent the Seven-fold Gift of the Holy Spirit given us at Baptism and strengthened in Confirmation: Wisdom, Understanding, Reverence (Piety), Right Judgment, Courage (Fortitude), Knowledge, Wonder and Awe in God's Presence (Fear of the Lord) After you light the candles, **pray the following Prayer Litany.**

To each gift all respond: We thank you, Holy Spirit.

Leader: For the gift of love... For the gift of peace... For the gift of wisdom... For the gift of understanding... For the gift of strength... For the gift of knowing the Lord... For the gift of our family... Amen.
