Suggested text for faith sharing: Today’s 2nd Reading 2 Cor. 13: 11-13 Access today’s Scriptures <http://www.usccb.org/bible/readings/060720.cfm>

Step One: As you hear this reading, what single line from St. Paul touches your heart? What is there in this reading that really speaks to your soul?

Step Two: Look into Your Life

Question for Children: When people love each other, how do they treat each other? **Question for Youth:** The Trinity is celebrated today. How would you describe your relationship with God the Father? With Jesus? With the Spirit? **Question for Adults:** If you were to encourage the members of your own parish to live as a “community of love,” which is how we define the Trinity, how would you advise them to live? Use St. Paul’s list of exhortations as your starting point.

OSV Activity of the Week

Invite your family or household members to talk about the characteristics of a household in which people would want to live. What would it be like? How would people behave? How would this household treat strangers, or the poor, or others in need? Remind everyone that such a household is very close to what the Trinity is: a community of love.
