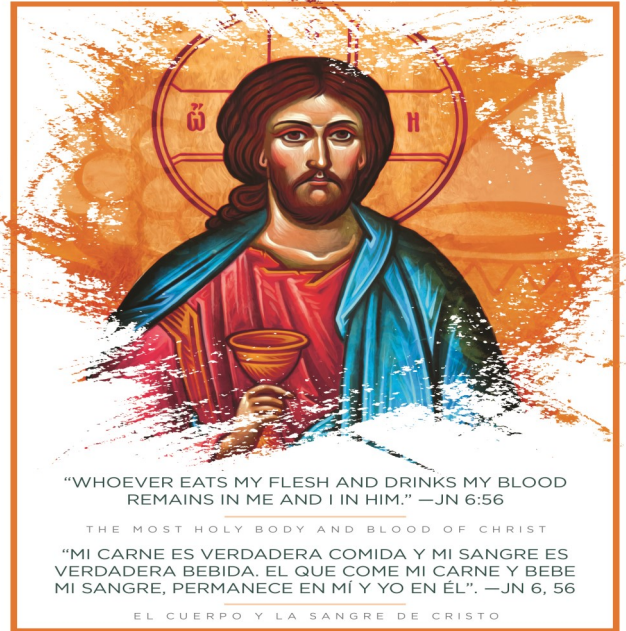




Cathedral of the Sacred Heart

“Confirmation is a starting line for intentional and missionary disciples. It is a Pentecost in our time and space where God extravagantly offers Grace and members of the Body of Christ respond “Yes” – “Amen” to being sealed and set apart for God’s purposes as a Temple of the Holy Spirit.” This is a mantra of sorts for those of us who journey alongside youth and adults preparing their hearts and minds to receive the outpouring of the Gift of the Holy Spirit. They are coached to embrace a lifestyle of growing in their relationship with Christ and His Church to include personal and public prayer (Mass and the Sacraments); study, love of self and neighbor and moral witness.

We encourage them to stay engaged in study of the Bible and the catechism with others-. We advise them to take every issue of conscience to the Light of Christ: through the Word, the catechism and church leaders for guidance and the lives of the Communion of Saints for example. Now is such a time for all of us. Let us look to God’s Word and our Bishops for formation on the issue of racism. In 2018 the Bishops of the United States wrote a pastoral letter, *Open Wide Our Hearts: the enduring call to love.* Now is a good time to explore the Church’s teaching on this issue.
