- Mass Weekdays (Tuesday-Friday) @ 12N and at 4pm Saturday & Sunday 8:30am & 11:30 am. Please call in advance for seating. We will continue with private prayer M-F @ 8-9am & 5-6pm (Morning Prayer at 8:30am and Evening Prayer at 5:30pm.); an opportunity for private prayer will continue on Saturday from 2:30-3:30 pm with the Sacrament of Reconciliation available.
- Masks are required at all times. Please bring your own mask. We ask that you arrive 15 minutes prior to the Mass time to get checked in.
- Please remain home if you are feeling ill or susceptible to the virus. Mass will continue to be livestreamed at 11:30 am every Sunday.

Liturgy of the Hours/Divine Office. Did you know that a small community of parishioners prays the Liturgy of the Hours (Divine Office) weekdays in the Cathedral? The Church is open for an hour at 8am and 5pm with Morning Prayer at 8:30am and evening prayer at *5:30pm. This ancient prayer is Scripture based – comprised of psalms, canticles, readings, and prayers for the Church and world. It is 15 minutes of prayer by the baptized in, with, and through Christ as the Head of His Body.

. Come and discover for yourselves why so many are passionate about this prayer which reminds us that the graces of the sacrifice of the Mass sanctify the day.
