As you all now we need to get the AC up and running so here is some information on how you can help us out! Thank you again for your continual generosity to the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart.

Air Condition Repair Fund:

As you are aware our AC quit working some weeks ago. We have tried several fixes, but so far none have worked. In short the repair will cost \$7,000.00. Fortunately, we have a parishioner who will match up to \$3,000 in gifts from the rest of us dedicated to the repair of the AC. This is a real blessing & will go a long way toward getting the repairs paid for. If you wish to make a dedicated donation toward matching this gift, you may do so in 3 ways:

1. Cash/check and put Air Conditioning in the memo field of the check or place cash in an envelope and either place it in the collection basket or mail in to the office or drop it off during business hours of 9-4 M-F.
2. Pay by Credit/Debit Card, you may call the Parish Office & use it over the phone or stop by the office to run it through our machine, or through our website by going to MyEOffering portal choose the HVAC Church tab this also allows you to also pay by check or credit card.
