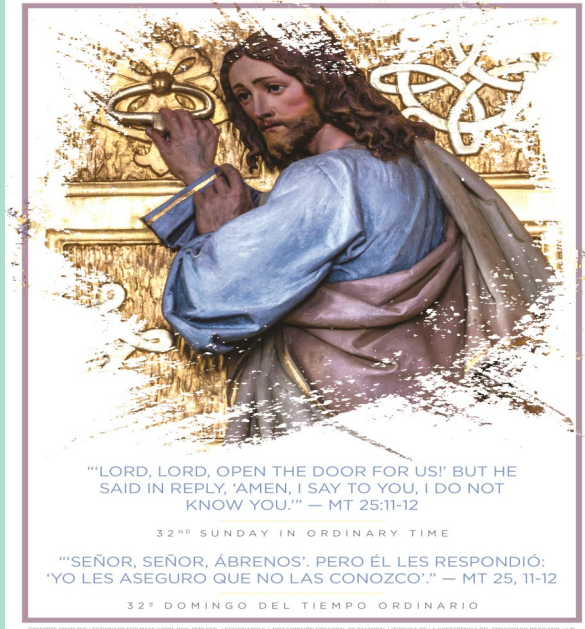


## Cathedral of the Sacred Heart
