**In person gatherings faith formation gatherings are postponed, but opportunities for ongoing formation abound!**

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. Next week, Advent begins the new Church year. This week, we acknowledge that Jesus is the Lord and center of our lives. Advent finds us waiting and watching for Emmanuel, God with Us, a paradox indeed. Looking for online resources to help you unpack these topics from your homes, I realized how many videos contained subtle errors in substance and practice that changes meaning. A challenge indeed, but one not unfamiliar to us as followers of Jesus. Check out one of the earliest controversies below.

**Jesus: Fully God and Fully Human.** What difference does this make? Bishop Barron tackles “Arianism” in this great 30-minute video that helps us understand what the words we profess in the Nicene Creed mean. You can watch it here. It’s a little ‘heady’ but worth watching, pondering and discussing. What strikes you as you listen?

To consider and discuss: 1) How does believing this truth affect the way I move through life? How does this belief shape my attitudes, choices, and actions? How does it affect my relationship with Jesus? And how does this relationship with Jesus affect my relationship with others?
