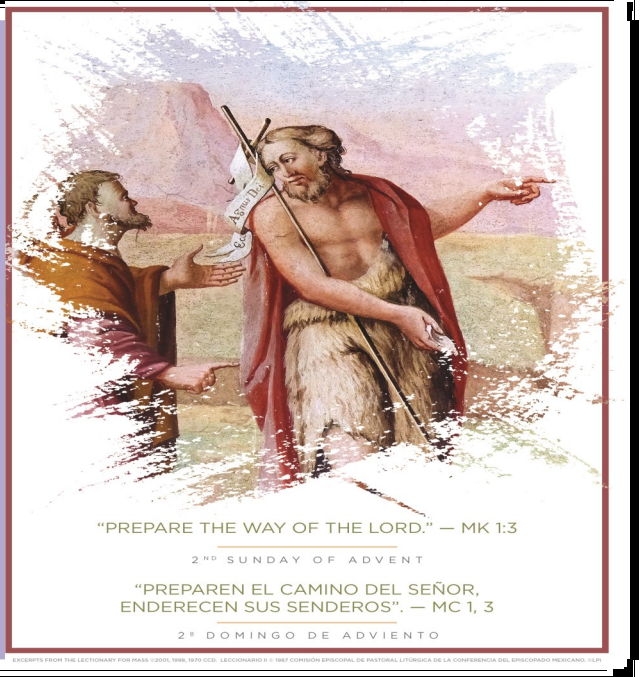


Cathedral of the Sacred Heart

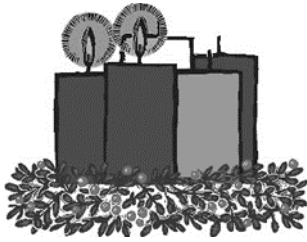

A circle of evergreens with 3 purple and a rose candle representing the 4 weeks of Advent and a white candle, representing Christ, to light on Christmas day is all you need. (flameless candles are recommended.) Today's prayer when you light the second purple candle, "Jesus Christ, Key of David, the gates of heaven open at your command. Come and show us the way to salvation and peace. Amen."
