**Second Sunday, Second Meal Project.** Cathedral's team of volunteers made about 100 sandwiches this past Sunday. We have reduced the number of lunches made in response to the needs of the neighbors we are serving. In the 8 months since the loss of the homeless shelter volunteers have made and distributed roughly 14,000 PBJ's— about 1,300 from our little community! Now, one month into the operation of the temporary warming shelter, our role is shifting. PBJ fixings are being sent with folks into homes/camps so they can prepare their own sandwiches. The 100 sandwiches we made, along with the donations of individually packed snacks and fresh fruit were shared with the folks who are using the warming shelter on 9th and Blake. Those who gathered for 2nd Sunday project also put together various Care Kits, e.g. laundry and mini 1st Aid kits. Thank you for saying "Yes" to sharing your time, talent and treasure!
