### Dear parishioners of Sacred Heart Cathedral,

Last year, Bishop Berg unveiled for the diocese of Pueblo a new strategic plan for the diocese. A strategic plan that invites us to join in a united effort to be living disciples involved in a common mission, a mission of evangelization stemming from the diversity of cultures represented by Catholics of Southern Colorado. One of the key elements of that strategic plan is the health and care of our priests. Through the generosity of the priests in our diocese the Gospel has been proclaimed and Sacraments distributed to many for over seventy-five years. Unfortunately, we are at a time when the rate of retirement and death of clergy is currently outpacing the number of vocations.

With the care of priests in mind, Bishop Berg, with the assistance of the Presbyteral Council and College of Consultors, has asked that each parish take a hard look at the weekend schedule of liturgies and decide upon one Mass to eliminate from their weekend schedule. This directive goes out to all the parishes located in the county of Pueblo, but will soon be asked of the other parishes as well. By eliminating one mass from the weekend schedule, it would be easier for a priest to find a replacement for vacations or emergency leaves for family emergencies. It is also hoped that these changes would free a priest to travel throughout the deanery or diocese as a fill-in priest or extra clergy for ministry to the sick and dying.

After consultation with Monsignor Jim, the parish council, finance council, parish staff and parish leadership team, we have decided upon the following weekend schedule for the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart:

- Saturday confessions at 2:30p.m. followed by Mass at 4p.m.
  - Sunday morning Mass will be celebrated at 8:30a.m. and another Mass at 11:30a.m.
- \*\*\* thus, eliminating our 10:15a.m. Mass.

I know that any change in Mass schedule can be a challenge to many, but I feel that we can all work through this change with patient understanding that it is for the future health and welfare of our priests and the welfare of us all. I also believe that the new schedule for Sunday can be a great benefit to the strengthening of our community. The time between the two Sunday Masses would allow for more opportunities of growth as a great time for faith formation for all ages; it can be a great time to have community building experiences, such as, parish breakfasts or continued outreach.

The plan for this new Mass schedule is to begin with the first weekend of Lent, Saturday, March 9. Please join me in prayer that this transition may be a time of renewal for us all. May we all take time to prepare our hearts and minds for the new schedule with expectant joy and anticipation for spiritual growth. God Bless You all.
