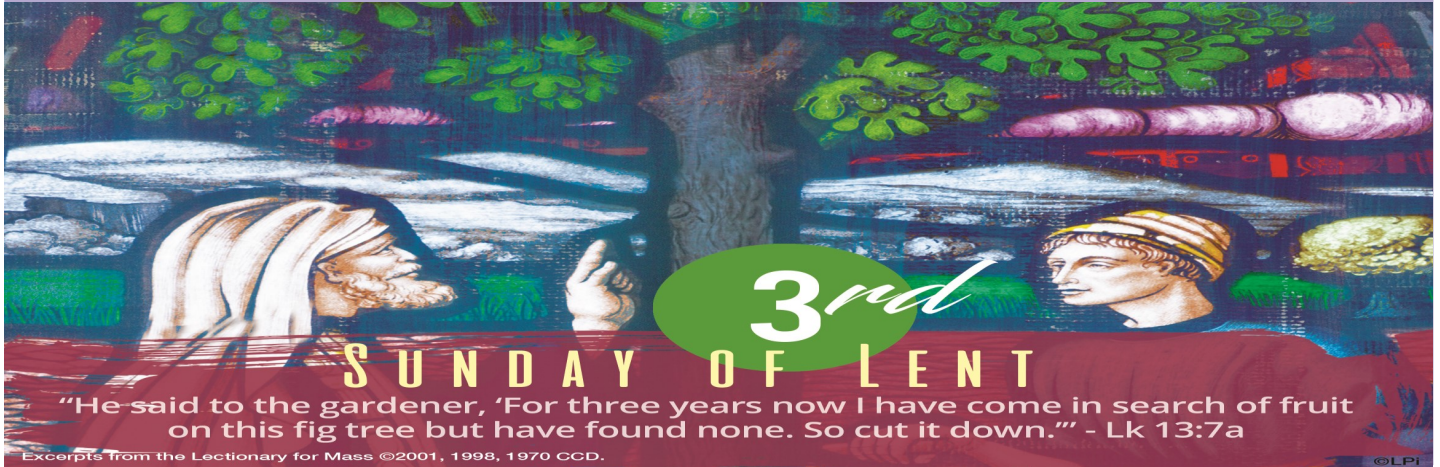


Cathedral of the Sacred Heart

Parish Mission! We invite you to join in a parish wide program, Doors of Mercy – today! – Sunday March 24 and Sundays April 7, and April 28th from 9:45am-11:15am in the Parish Hall (gym). Fr. Derrek has adapted the ‘Doors of Mercy’ into a mission experience for our parish family. Come! Experience God’s hope, healing and loving mercy in this once-in-a-lifetime program. Even if you’ve never participated before, please, ‘each and every one of you’, join us! You’ll be so glad you did.

What is a “Scrutiny” and why would we ask Lawrence – or anyone else- to undergo one? A Scrutiny is one of the preparation Rites celebrated by adults and older children before their Baptism, Confirmation and First Communion at the upcoming Easter Vigil. Lawrence will participate in this Rite at the 8:30am Mass on the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays of Lent. To scrutinize means to look closely at something. In Lawrence’s case, as he prepares for his Initiation, he is asked to examine his life carefully to find anything within himself that would keep him from following Christ. For our part, his sponsoring community, we ask Christ to heal what is broken and strengthen him that he may resist further temptations. Lawrence, we stand with you, we pray for you, O holy child of God!

Our Sunday Visitor Question of the Week. As we continue our own Lenten journeys of conversion, we ask ourselves, “What needs changing in my life right now? What steps can I take during Lent to make sure this happens? What steps am I taking to make sure my faith bears fruit in good works?”
