Whenever a Catholic community is blessed to have someone who will celebrate Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation at the upcoming Easter Vigil, Scrutinies are celebrated and Cycle A Readings are used. These proclamations speak to the change of heart and lifestyle, (conversion), the person is saying "Yes" to. In solidarity with Lawrence, the 8:30 Mass community will hear the story of the man born blind and the rising of Lazarus. Let us all keep Lawrence, his family and all those who seek conversion in their lives in our prayers.
