Easter Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday.

The 40 days of Lent conclude before the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. This Mass marks the beginning of the Easter Triduum. While they take place over 3 days, the services that happen during this time – are liturgically one - unfolding the unity of Christ's living, dying, and rising (Paschal Mystery). Participating in all 3 Triduum services is, in itself, a way to be formed in faith. One of the best ways to do this is to imagine yourself in the story. Our faith formation families are encouraged to participate fully in the celebrations listed below. You may wish to use the ideas associated with each celebration as a source for reflections and prayer.

### **Triduum Services:**

**Mass of the Lord's Supper** – Thursday, April 18 at 7pm—Picture sitting with Jesus and the disciples as he celebrates the Last Supper. What does his voice sound like? What is the expression on his face? How do you feel when he comes to you to wash your feet? What does it mean to you when Jesus says to you, what I have done for you? “I have given you a model to follow, so that as I have done for you, you should also do.”

**Good Friday of the Lord's Passion** – Friday, April 19 at 12 Noon. (“Living Stations”- Gaze into Jesus' eyes as he receives his death sentence from Pilate; witness the exchange between Jesus and His Mother, feel the forgiveness that flows from Jesus on the Cross.

**Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord (Easter Vigil)** – Saturday, April 20 beginning at 7:45pm

Hear the story of salvation history recounted culminating in the fulfillment of God's promises Accompany the women to the tomb where Jesus' body was laid. What is the expression on their face: 1) when two men with dazzling garments appeared and spoke to them of the risen Jesus; 2) as they remembered Jesus words about rising, and 3) when their proclamation of faith in Jesus' resurrection was met with disbelief. How do the ritual elements of holy fire and water – the Body and Blood of Christ – speak to and form your faith?

**Easter Sunday Masses will be celebrated at 8am; 10am and 12 Noon. (note only this Sunday)**

Let us go forth into the Easter season testifying to His great love for us with our lives! Rejoice!!
