Fr. Derrek's new Bible Study series – **Priest, Prophet and King** – continues next week at 9:45 in the Parish Hall (Gym) . Check it out!

They will know we are Christians by our love! Since last August, Cathedral 'PBJ Angels' have made about 5,000 sandwiches to help feed the homeless and hungry in our community. When the homeless shelter closed its doors last summer, Pueblo not only lost a place for people to sleep, it lost the 2nd meal of the day offered to people who are struggling to feed themselves and their families. The evening meal that was prepared at the shelter, like the Noon meal at the Soup Kitchen, was open all who are hungry. Until a permanent shelter is renovated and open and an evening meal is being prepared, we will continue to gather on the 2nd Sunday to prepare sandwiches for distribution. About 400 sandwiches are distributed weekly. Our monthly offering will be added to that of others so that fewer Pueblo neighbors will go to sleep hungry. Next month, we will be making summer themed Care Kits as well as sandwiches. We are in need of sunscreen, bug spray, sun glasses, lip balm, caps, and empty prescription bottles to hold sewing kit items. Please continue to pray and advocate for the most vulnerable members of our community. Thank you so much for preaching the Good News through your actions. You are so appreciated and remembered in prayers of thanksgiving for your generosity and commitment.
