Marriage Moment. Ascension "Thursday" is often celebrated on the nearest Sunday. Let's not be picky about dates but find a way to 'lift up' your beloved today - a compliment, a favor, or maybe just be silly and fly a kite together.

The Ascension of Jesus. So What? It can be an abstraction for us today. But imagine for a moment what it was like for the early Church. Jesus, their beloved Rabbi (teacher and Lord) had been crucified on the cross, died and his body sealed in a tomb. The end. No! On the third day, He rose in a glorified body - appearing to believers - who recognized Him in the breaking open of the Scriptures and the Breaking of the Bread (The Eucharist). Alleluia!!! The end? Not yet... On the '40th' day after His Resurrection he ascended into heaven. (In the Creed, we pray "He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father.) Gone again? Hardly! His Ascension paved the way for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon His followers, transforming them from a frightened remnant hiding out in fear for their lives - to a force of Love that through their witness continued to transform the world. This reality is exactly what we celebrate here and now - on Pentecost and through the Sacrament of Confirmation. As 'temples of the Holy Spirit and flesh and blood 'tabernacles,' we carry the Love of the Lord deep in our hearts. His Loves for all creation - especially the most vulnerable - now flows through us, the Church, the Mystical Body of Christ. The story and the Mission of Jesus the Christ now becomes - in a real and substantive way - our story and our Mission. A story written in the details of our lives. This week as we prepare for Confirmation, let us take time to consider how intentionally we have been a part of the Mission and ministry of Jesus the Christ. How receptive are we really to the power and inspiration of the seven fold Gift of the Holy Spirit and the transformative Grace of receiving the Body and Blood of Christ?
