Did you know that being a Godparent is an official ministry of the Church regulated by Canon law? This is because the role of mentoring someone in the faith is so important. The Church requires that the Godparent be a fully initiated Catholic who is currently active in his or her parish and participating fully in the Sacramental life of the Church. In other words, the Godparent has been not only been Baptized and Confirmed s/he understands the importance of participation in the Mass weekly, Reconciliation (Confession/Pence) regularly, is following the church's guidance regarding the Sacrament of Marriage and – with God's help and mercy - is striving to love their neighbor as themselves and God above all. Often, the one chosen to be the Godparent of an infant or small child, serves as role model and guide for the parents as well. Many Catholic adults have not had the opportunity to complete their own initiation through reception of Communion and/or Confirmation.
