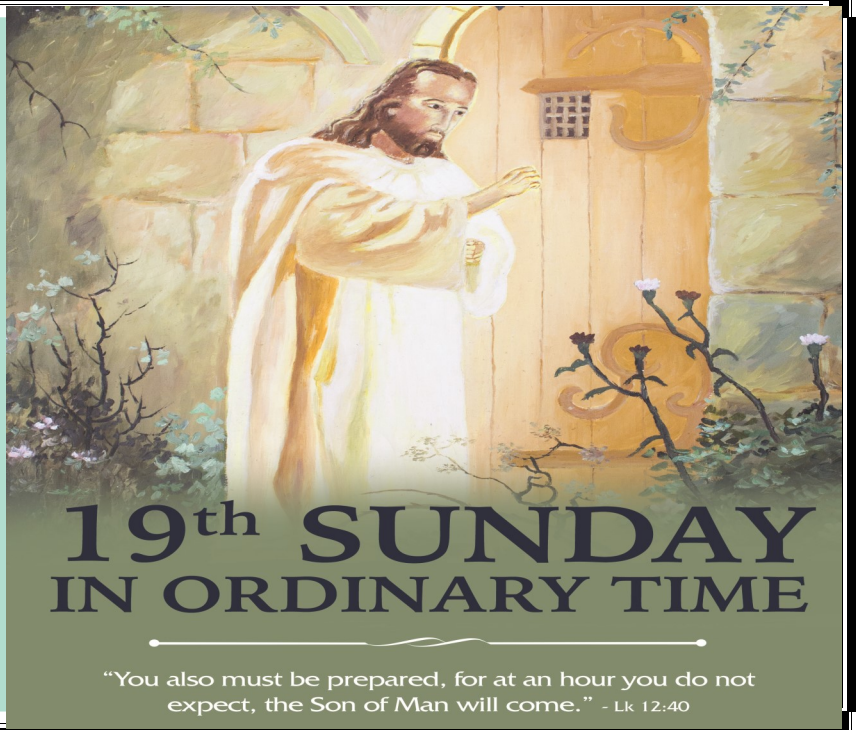


Cathedral of the Sacred Heart
