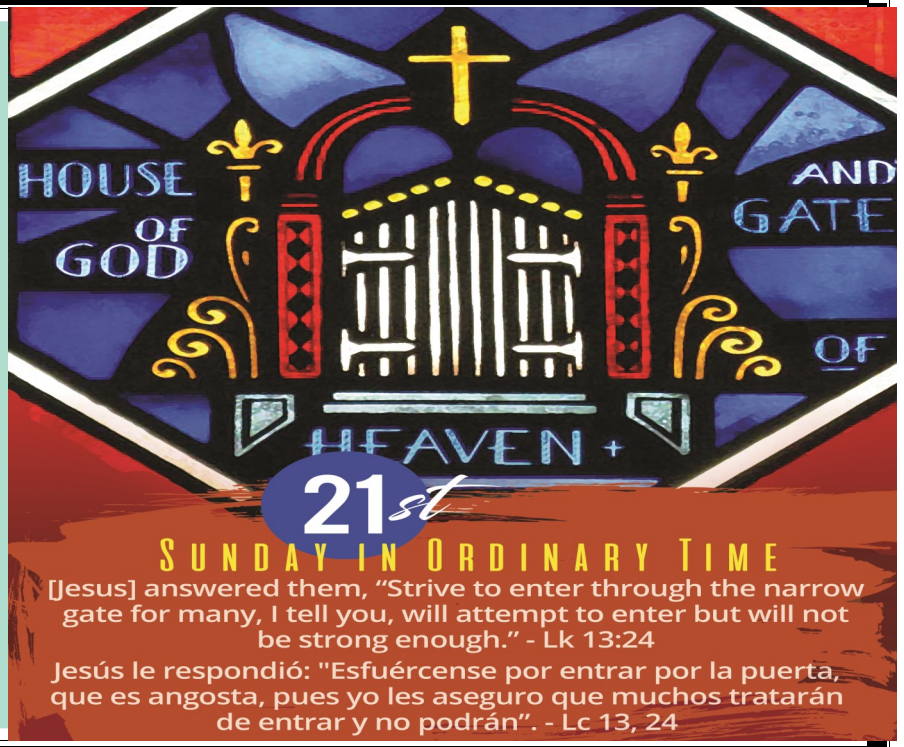




Cathedral of the Sacred Heart

Faith formation in light of our building woes.

First and foremost, it is important for us to embrace a truth: forming disciples is not dependent on a building or a school year model of classes. It is about developing and deepening a relationship with Christ and His Church. That occurs within community -- around the Lord's Table, with the telling of "The Story" and our recognizing Christ in the Breaking of Bread. Most centrally, it is dependent upon the right ordering of our lives as an offering through -- with and in Christ in the unity of the Holy Spirit to God the Father. Our life that is 'hidden with Christ in God' is surely nourished and strengthened by his Real Presence. The risen Christ is really present in and to the Church at Mass in four unique ways: 1) in the Word of God; 2) in the person of the minister; 3) in the assembled people; and most especially -- 4) in the Eucharist broken and shared. Classes will happen eventually. Mass is happening NOW! Please -- let us not neglect the health and development of the Mystical Body of Christ, the church community, while we wait for a building to be remodeled. Please, bring your family to Mass on Sunday and let us continue to renovate our lives in Christ!
