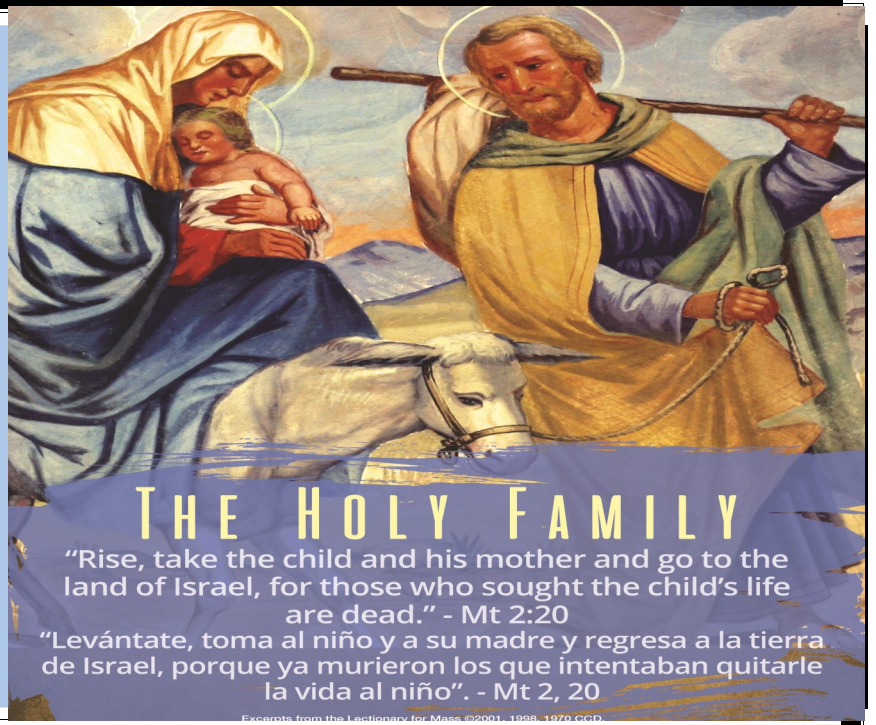

Hospital Visitation: Due to Federal Regulations, our hospitals can no longer supply names or other information about patients.
