First Communion and First Confession News. Being a member of the community that attends Mass weekly and participating in on-going faith formation (here, at a Catholic school, or via an approved home study) is required for those for preparing for a Sacrament. At the orientation meeting, parents order or receive materials to prepare their children at home. Children begin with First Confession (Reconciliation) preparation. First Communion preparation begins after their child's 1st Confession readiness interview and 1st Confession. Families who begin now may have their children prepared for their First Communion readiness interview with Fr. Derrek in mid to late May. A group First Communions will be celebrated on June 14, 2020.
