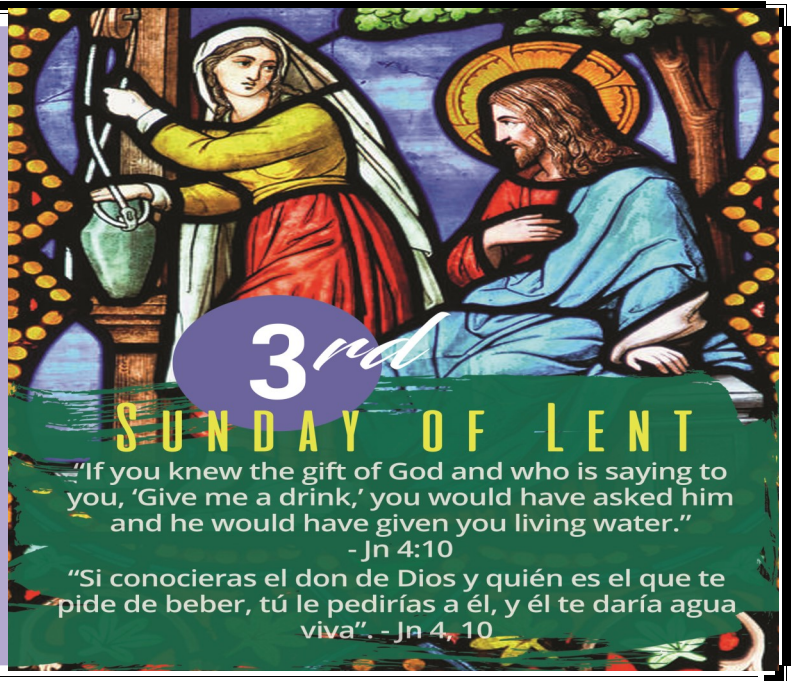


## Cathedral of the Sacred Heart

**TODAY (Sunday)** What is the Good News? March 15th 9:45am -11:15am – Church. Dr. Seth Wright, Director of Missionary Discipleship for the Diocese of Pueblo will be here to lead an interactive presentation to help us come to a deeper appreciation of Jesus, and enter more fully into the freedom he offers us. **What are the Scrutinies?** They are very special rites celebrated on the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays of Lent at Masses where the Elect are present. The Elect are the members of our community who, while preparing for Baptism have celebrated the Rite of Acceptance and been enrolled in the Book of the Elect as those chosen for Initiation this Easter Vigil. As a part of this rite the Elect are encouraged to scrutinize – closely examine - their lives for those obstacles which stand between them and a life of faithful discipleship as a follower of Jesus the Christ. Their example inspires us to join in this examination. For the Elect – the waters of Baptism will wash away their sins and bring them healing and strength. The Grace of the Sacrament of Reconciliation affords those of us already Baptized with forgiveness of sin and the restoration of our Baptismal dignity.

**OSV Activity of the Week** Gather together as a family to examine how the Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are coming along. Use this week as a time to turn your hearts back to God. Have each family member name one or two things he or she will do as a sign of wanting to return to God.

**Pray...**for all those world-wide affected by the coronavirus, those who are sick, the caregivers, researchers, the quarantined, the anxious, and those working to prevent the spread of the disease. Extend this prayer to all those sick and suffering. Remember to pray for those you meet each day, you never know what they are experiencing.
