OSV Activity of the Week. Choose a television program the family has watched or a story in the newspaper or a magazine. Look for modern temptations that cause people to do the wrong thing. Discuss with your family: What are some of the most difficult temptations people face today? What is the best way to deal with these temptations?

Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are the three principal practices of Lent. Discuss with your family what it means to fast or give something up for Lent. The Lenten practice of fasting is meaningful for children when it coincides with almsgiving. As a family, consider sharing a simple meal each week and then using the money saved to help a local charity or CRS Rice Bowl.
